



A 2020 National Nursing Workforce Survey showed that the nursing workforce is falling short of this recommendation, with just over 65% of registered nurses having a bachelor's degree or greater. Multiple studies have shown that nurses who are baccalaureate-prepared deliver

better patient outcomes. Supporting WVU nursing programs is also an excellent way to build a more prosperous future for state residents. For example, a career in nursing with a median pay more than \$80,000 is well above the median household income in West Virginia of \$55,000.


