The "View All" button opens a running list of stories in that category, in this case, Announcements. (see below)

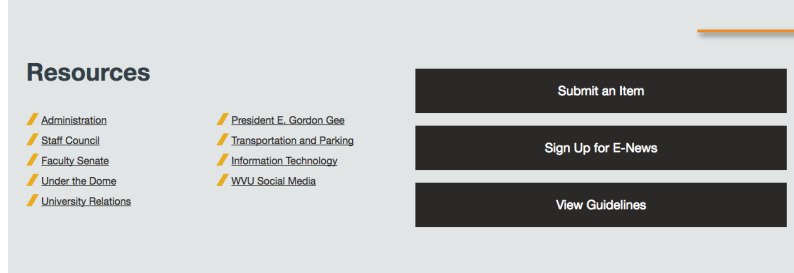
